Eligibility: The regatta is open to any classes providing at least three entries. Classes requesting a start should email Triton499@gmail.com by Sunday 16 September 2018

Rendezvous: At 0830 in vicinity of "77" FI G 2.5s (approximately 2 nm south of Cove Point).

Radio: Boats should monitor VHF 71 for courtesy communications from the Race Committee.

Start: Between yellow or orange flag on Race Committee boat and "77" FI G 2.5s or nearby inflatable mark.

The first warning signal is scheduled for 0900. The planned starting sequence is as follows:

0900	Warning	
0905	Start	J35, PHRF A1, PHRF A2
0910	Start	J105, PHRF NS
0915	Start	CRCA**, all sub-classes

*Yachts in classes having few entries will be combined to ensure all yachts will be competing for at least one award at the discretion of the race committee

**The Race Committee will use a white streamer for all CRCA sub-classes

Signals: RRS 26 "Starting Races".

Event Sailing Instructions will be available on the SSC website www.shearwatersc.net not later than 1700 on Friday 21 September 2018.

Course: Leave RW "CP" Mo (A) WHIS to port, leave GC "77B" to starboard. The Cove Point LNG Terminal must be left to port.

Finish: Between yellow or orange flag on Race Committee boat and West River G"1" FL G 4s. Course is 33.8 nm.

Time Limit: 1900 for all classes. Boats not finishing within two hours of the first boat in their class to finish will be scored TLE and awarded points equal to the number of finishers plus two, but in no case more than the number of starters. This changes RRS 35 and A4.1.

Scoring: PHRF classes will be scored using PHRF of the Chesapeake Random Leg ratings. Other handicap classes entering should confer with the organizer on the ratings to be used.

Protests: Mail to SSC Race Committee, at address above, postmarked no later than Monday 24 September 2018. Hearing at a time and place to be announced.

Awards: 1st/3, 2nd/5, 3rd/7 & 4th/10+ starters. Additional awards may be given at the discretion of the Race Committee.

Other: Handicap classes other than PHRF should contact the organizer, Triton499@gmail.com, regarding the ratings to be used for their class(es).
